



Terms & Rental Agreement Countrywide Sanitation

Completion of this rental agreement is required prior to the delivery of Countrywide Sanitation Containers, or "boxes" at the placement site.

Hazardous Materials

Hazardous Materials are not accepted for disposal. Hazardous Materials include but are not limited to asbestos containing materials, paints, liquids of any nature, solvents, septic tank pumping's, sludges, dead animals, fluorescent light bulbs, light ballasts, electronics, batteries, tires, oil, gasoline, appliances, and yard waste. A fee will be assessed for Hazardous Materials based on the quantity, origin, and level of contamination. Items such as tires and appliances can be disposed of for a separate handling fee.

Container Loading

Containers or "boxes" should be filled no higher than flush with the top of the container or "box". Containers or "boxes" with materials hanging over the edge or stacked beyond the height of the container walls, known as "Overage," may not be removed. Countrywide Sanitation reserves the right to refuse service if and when containers do not comply with the requirements and regulations of the "Department of Transportation". A fee will be incurred for the attempted service.

Containers or "boxes" exceeding the countrywide sanitation weight limit of 10 tons will be assessed an additional fee of \$275.00 per ton in overage. Overage fees will be assessed and billed to the existing form of payment on the account, reflecting the final weight of the container or "box". The first 10 days of the rental agreement are rent free. A fee will be assessed after 10 days of the container or "box" inactivity. Inactivity can be defined as the contents of the container or "box" being disposed; or the container or "box" being requested for removal from the placement site.

Containers or "boxes" filled with materials not agreed upon "Mispriced" with Countrywide prior to service pick up at the placement site, will be assessed an additional fee. Items originally agreed upon are priced and quoted based on removal fees. Items not agreed upon prior to service will be classified as "Mispriced" and an additional fee will be applied to account for special disposal need. A fee will be incurred for this service.

Additional Fees

Additional fees may be assessed for materials collected that are deemed "Hazardous", "Overage", "Mispriced", or other circumstances outside of Countrywide Sanitation Company's control.

Personal Property Waiver

Countrywide Sanitation is not liable for damage of any kind incurred at the placement site or the surrounding area within the property or the area deemed as the "driveway" or "parking lot". Countrywide Sanitation Co. is not liable for any damage that the weight of the boxes and/or trucks may cause to the surface of the placement site. Countrywide Sanitation will not be head liability for personal injury and death incurred by negligence or willful misconduct by any party or person when using Countrywide Sanitation property at the container placement site.
